**Fabboli Cellars Takes Multiple Medals in International Wine Competition**

**Leesburg, VA, July 8, 2009-** Fabboli Cellars, a local winery in Loudon County, recently competed and won an impressive four medals in the Indy International wine competition.

This contest is one of the largest in the United States, with over 3,000 wineries from 10 countries competing in this three day June event. Seventy-two judges reviewed the wines based on appearance, aroma, taste and finish. The results of this competition resulted in a double gold medal for Fabboli's 2007 Cabernet Franc Reserve. Gold medals were awarded to the new 2008 "Rosa Luna" Rosé, and the 2007 Tre Soréle. Also the 2007 Chambourcin received a silver medal.

This notable showing is not only great recognition for the county but for the Virginia wine industry. "It's nice to get the recognition, for the energy and focus we put into quality. I always want to put the best I can in the bottle. It makes me feel great that others appreciate this effort," said Doug Fabboli, wine maker and owner.
